Loughlin Takes a Stand on Illegal Alien Crisis

John Loughlin, Republican candidate for Congress in RI-1, today criticized the Obama administration for filing suit against the state of Arizona over its soon-to-be-implemented illegal immigration law.

“This is an appalling waste of taxpayer dollars,” said Loughlin. “If the federal government did its job, secured the borders appropriately and made sure that there would be no economic reward for entering this country illegally, Arizona would not have been forced into action.”

“Instead of sending lawyers from Washington to sue the people of Arizona,” Loughlin said, “the administration should be sending soldiers to work with law enforcement officials in Arizona to close the border.”

“I’ve just returned from a trip to Arizona and had the good fortune to tour Pinal County with Sheriff Paul Babeu by helicopter and walk the border with Sheriff Larry Dever of Cochise County. I have seen the problem firsthand and understand the frustration that forced Arizona lawmakers to act.”
