Loughlin Launches “John’s Job Tour” In Woonsocket

John Loughlin, Republican candidate for Congress in RI-1 today launched “John’s Job Tour” with visits to two longtime Woonsocket businesses, the Soucy Insurance Agency and Look N See Optical Shoppe.

“During this recession we’ve heard platitudes from the Obama administration and leaders in Congress promising that their policies will bring more jobs to the state, but the truth is that we’ve just created more debt,” said Loughlin. “The federal stimulus package and the bailouts helped Wall Street but left Main Street out in the cold. The health of our economy is based on the success of small businesses and it’s about time that small they get the kind of attention that we’ve given to big business.”
