Loughlin Receives NFIB Endorsement

Launches Small Business Owners for Loughlin

John Loughlin, candidate for Congress in RI-1 today held a news conference to discuss his support of initiatives that would help small businesses by rejecting tax hikes, eliminating government red tape, and increasing access to credit.

“From Manville to Adamsville, the first congressional district is full of thousands of small businesses that employ thousands of Rhode Islanders. It is essential that we all work together to ensure their success,” said Loughlin.

Loughlin’s small business initiatives include eliminating the requirement for businesses to file a 1099 for every vendor with a receipt over \$600, maintaining the 2001 and 2003 tax cuts and ensuring that small businesses have access to capital.

Chris Carozzi, Regional Grassroots Manager for the National Federation of Independent Business joined Loughlin at the news conference to announce NFIB’s endorsement of John Loughlin’s campaign for Congress in RI-1.

Calling Loughlin “one of our own,” NFIB noted that his experience operating a television, radio and film production company gives him a unique view of business concerns that can quickly and easily be applied to national legislative leadership.

“If America is to regain its economic footing, it’s going to take people like John Loughlin in Washington fighting big government’s tax-and-spend policies,” said Lisa Goeas, NFIB’s vice president for political operations.

“John is committed to controlling runaway spending before it consumes America’s economy,” Goeas said. “He’s determined to join the effort to restore common sense to fiscal policy and help enact laws that will reduce the oppressive tax and paperwork burden on Main Street businesses.”
